Label News

Stomp Off

For some time there has been an 'official' British distributor for this American label but their delivery speed and stock levels have certainly not been good. I have now arranged to obtain supplies through my regular American wholesaler and this will mean two things. Firstly I am able to drop the price by 80p and secondly supplies should be reliable if not that speedy. I have listed the entire catalogue on pages 3 to 5 and am assured that the list is complete. Other albums are listed on the 'Jazzbymail / Stomp Off' website but these are only available as 'downloads'. I will be placing an order on Friday 25th January so please let me have any orders by then.

Mosaic Singles

I have been asked for these a number of times and now find that they can be obtained other than direct from the company in Connecticut albeit at a price which is higher than the 'direct' price. A small stock of some albums will be arriving soon and others can be ordered although they might take a while to come through.

Spanish Labels

or should I say Andorran! Thankfully the labels such as Lonehill, Gambit, EJC, Jazzbeat and now a new one, Jazz Track, keep raiding the back catalogues of the giants of the industry and producing welcome additions to the shelves. To me this activity simply shows that there is a market for 'old' jazz whatever the the big boys think and say! The new issues which are not included in the details listings will be available in a couple of weeks.

EMI Blue Note

It is a little worrying that the EMI empire has now been taken over by another venture capital enterprise and have announced that 'restructuring' of the company will take place with a view to 'increasing profitability'. To me this sound very ominous to anyone interested in minority interest music such as jazz. Even more ominous is the complete lack of any new Blue Note reissues on their dealer website in the next couple of months. This could be a sign of things to come so if you want any currently available Blue Note issues such as the many Rudy Van Gelder 'remasters' now is the time to buy. A visit to www.bluenote.co.uk will show you that they still have a pretty extensive catalogue.

Ambassador / Evening Star

These are two small labels, one American and one Swedish which have a number of very interesting issues albeit somewhat different in style. All the issues have pretty good availability.

Payment by Credit Card

In future it will be essential for me to have details of the three digit security number on the back of the card for all credit and debit card transactions. The company who process these transactions now charge me a premium rate of commission when I bypass the use of this number which I do for a number of you who have been customers for a number of years. In future when completing order forms please ensure the number is quoted in the appropriate place and also include it in any orders sent by letter, fax or email.

Postal Rates

This is by way of advance notification that there will be a restructuring of my postal charges again in April when the new rates are announced. Rather than increase my charges again I will have to give serious consideration to using second class mail which I have always avoided until now. This could be done with customers being charged a premium if they required first class post. Some of you may have noticed that I experimented with a franking machine before Christmas but I soon found that any savings on postal charges were soon outweighed by the machine rental and other incidental charges! Anyway using a franking machine took business away from my local sub-post office and we should all be doing what we can to keep these fine institutions going! If you have any thoughts on the matter please let me know.

As usual orders can be placed by phone, Fax , email or letter but please remember to include your full name and address. Unlike most of the major shops I am still very willing to take cheques because currently my bank does not charge for each individual cheque deposited. I just hope that this continues!

This time of years sees me planning my festival trips for the year and although the list is not complete it seems that in the next couple of months I shall be selling my wares at the "Jazz on a Winter's Weekend" at the Arts Centre, Southport on Friday 1st to Sunday 3rd February and at Warner's Sinah Warren hotel on Friday 29th February to Sunday 2nd March. Other venues including my usual haunts such as Keswick and Nairn will be announced later.

I am not really sorry to keep plugging this event as we want it to be a complete sell-out this year. Tickets are going well but there are still some available. There have been a couple of changes to the personnel since I included information in the newsletter in December. Jake Hanna, Norman Simmons and Michael Moore have had to withdraw for various reasons and their places are being taken by Chuck Riggs, Ben Aronov and Georgos Antoniou respectively. Day tickets are now available so even if you cannot make the entire weekend you will be very welcome to come for one or two days.
