Again this month there seems to be a generous helping of new releases which has caused me to get the newsletter out very quickly. In fact only just about four weeks from the last mailing. Anyway I believe there is a fairly good cross section of music to suit all tastes and pockets and hopefully you will too!

## **Label News**

### **Kazoo Lips / Sterling**

These are two American labels which I can now obtain through my American supplier. Initially I have brought in small stocks because until they arrived I had little idea of their content and quality. Kazoo Lips is a very small privately produced label which is issuing very obscure and rare recordings particularly aimed at the 'collector' market and whilst because of the very nature of the material the sound is not of the highest quality the restoration has been loving done. My criticism is levelled at the quality of the notes which could do with extra information being included. Maybe the rarity means that there is not much else available! "Sterling" CDs come in what appears to be a slim DVD case and some interesting material is included with good sound quality.

### **The George Buck Labels**

Stocks of all these have now arrived but because I had little prior information to go on and did not want to get stuck with stock that would not sell initial quantities are relatively small. More can be ordered fairly quickly once the current stocks are exhausted.

### **Classics**

I have listed the next five issues on this label but have no idea when they will arrive. Their issue programme is a little erratic compared with what it was a few years ago but I believe that they will turn up eventually!

### **New Release Information**

I glean the new release information which is printed on the first pages from a variety of sources including publicity from the record companies and various web-sites. In some instances no specific release date is given which means that there could be a wait for delivery. However I believe that you would prefer that I list what is happening in the future rather than just what has come in. Actually a number of the albums listed on the first few pages never do come in because it is unlikely that I will sell them although they are available on special order!

The 'new' and 'improved' web site is now up and running with only the secure ordering facility to be put into commission. For those of you with internet access you will find that navigation around the catalogue area is fairly user friendly and there are search facilities based on artist and tune title. The data base contains only a small proportion of the currently available CDs and hopefully over the next couple of months I will be able to find the time to copy in lots more album details culled from past issues of this newsletter as well as keeping up to date with new issues as they

arrive. If you can have a look and would like to let me have your comments my site designer, Ian Bateman, and I am quite ready to make any improvements you might suggest.

**Comment:-** The production of this CD has been a real labour of love by Scott Black given that the original acetates were rescued from a dumpster (or to us a 'skip'!) whilst the house of the late Raymond Burke was being cleared some while after his death. The sound quality is in many places rough but careful listening certainly gives strong credence to the theory that the white musicians of New Orleans played some excellent jazz and were very under-recorded.
