Dear Friends,

Until the beginning of last week I thought I was going to have difficulty in filling eight pages with news and new releases and suddenly around about one third of everything listed from page 5 onwards turned up so the last few days has been a flurry of forefingers! It also explains why this newsletter is a little late!

Anyway I hope the selection meets your demands, or at least some of them and you will be ordering!

## **Label News**

### **Acrobat**

I do not get new release information from this company so have to search around to see what is available. Whilst the majority will possibly be of no interest to most of you there are a number of jazz and blues releases which I have included. Their numbering system is a little bizarre so do not coincide with the order of release.

### **Sensation**

I have managed to obtain a small supply of some issues on this Canadian label which was owned by the late Jeff Healey. The quality is excellent with remastering being done by John R.T.Davies but I am not at all sure how long stocks will last. I would suggest that if you want copies of any of the five CDs you do not delay.

### **Such Sweet Thunder**

This is an American label which concentrates solely on recordings by David Berger's 'Sultans of Swing' big band which plays regularly at Birdland in New York. They are an excellent band within the swing genre and I was lucky enough to catch a performance of their last September. I am getting the CDs direct from David Berger and hopefully they will be in stock in about two weeks, depending on the method David uses to send the shipment!

## **American Supplies**

I know that some of you will have been waiting quite some time for certain albums which are being imported from the USA in particular CDs on the Kazoo Lips and Victoria labels. In both cases the order placed by my supplier in New York failed to make it to him in time for the main shipment. For reasons of economy Tom, in New York, and I have to accumulate a collection of around 200 CDs to ship at any one time and therefor it looks as though it might be a little while before these finally come in. As the accumulated order can include such labels as those from George Buck, Stomp Off, Mosaic, Collectable and others it does not usually take too much time however. Please bear with me.

## **Awaydays**

After the commitments of May the forthcoming two months will be considerably quieter with just a couple of Jazz Weekends. The first is from Friday 13th to Sunday

15th June which we will be at Mill Rythe Holiday Centre for a festival run by Jill and Pete Lay and the second is in July when from 10th to 13th the Record Bar will be open at the Whitley Bay Jazz Festival at the Village Hotel in Newcastle. Early August hopefully will see us at the Nairn Jazz Festival but details on this are rather sketchy at the moment.

One event which, sadly, I will not be attending is the Blackpool Jazz Party in October which unfortunately has been cancelled. Tom and Christine Baron started their event in 2000 and it had gained a reputation for being a great weekend of mainstream jazz so to see it end is very unfortunate. Maybe it will be resurrected sometime in the future.

### **Norwich Jazz Party**

The second Norwich Jazz Party took place at the beginning of last month and although I say it myself I think it was a great musical success with a great deal of really excellent jazz crammed into the three days. From what I have been told everyone who came has their own favourite sets but there seems to be a fairly general consensus that the highlights included the tribute to Allan Ganley, who was due to appear, in which an all-star big band under the direction of Ken Peplowski performed Allan's compositions and arrangements to an audience which included his widow, daughter and granddaughter. The more unusual compositions of Duke Ellington performed by a quintet led by Dan Block who also provided the specially written arrangements, Scott Robinson's set of arrangements of Thad Jones compositions, 'Rico's Biggest Little Band' with the music of John Kirby and a solo half-hour of of humour from Eddie Erickson were just four out of a total of thirty-four sets were also highlighted. The music was diverse although always within the general genre of 'swinging mainstream' and the toes were kept tapping.

It is on again next year and although the line-up of musicians has yet to be decided I do not think there will be that many changes as we can work of the principle of 'if it ain't broke don't fix it!'
