An increase to twelve pages this month mainly due to a couple of complete label listing which I believe you will find interesting. A pretty interesting collection all round given the time of year!

Label News

Upbeat

The distribution for this British label specialising in British trad jazz (with some exceptions!) has moved and although there is no change in the price I thought it was about time I included a full list of what is on offer. All should be ready available within very few days.

Venus

This Japanese, and rather expensive, label is another to receive different distribution in the UK. I have quoted a price based on the most recent quoted wholesale price but there is possibility that the actual cost to you will be a little bit lower. I hope so because although the sound quality is superb but the price does seem to put some people off.

Chiaroscuro

The good news is that the price for this label has gone down from £13.50 to £11.95. Next month I will include a complete up-to-date list of everything available. In the meantime I have included details of a selection of back issues which should appeal to those of you with a 'mainstream' musical taste. Having not seen any 'new releases' I am not sure how active the label is but there are very good available stocks of older issues.

George Buck Labels

Shortly before completing this newsletter I received brief details of the latest batch of issues on GHB Foundation labels (American Music, GHB, Jazzology, Audiophile, Circle, etc.) . I have ordered stocks of everything and hopefully they will be here early in the week commencing 18th so will be able to answer any queries you may have then.

Arbors

Very strange this company. A few months ago I listed a number of CD which were mentioned in their latest catalogue as coming out in the coming months. You will see on page 2 five new issues none of which appeared amongst the projected albums. Life is full of surprises and at least these are nice ones because they are all worth having!

Kazoo Lips

At last I have heard that the back ordered items on this label are on the way. I gather that the delay has been caused by a bolt of lightning! They should arrive with

Living Era

Recently I have received a number of orders for CDs on this label which have been recently reviewed in the Jazz Journal. Unfortunately the entire catalogue feel victim to Universal Music's 'rationalisation' at the beginning of the year when they took over the Sanctuary Group and everything has gone the same way as OJC, Concord (back catalogue), Good Time Jazz, Castle Pulse etc. etc. all of which have fallen into UMG's evil clutches!

Black Lion

The observant amongst you will see a new issue for the Black Lion label which must be the first for several years. I asked the distributor's rep if he knew of the Pete Allen album was the start of something but he did not know. I am hoping it might be as there are some real gems amongst the old catalogue but so far no news!
