## **Label News**

### **Bygone Days**

This is a new label being put together by some of the people behind the late-lamented 'Living Era' which was wiped out by the Universal Music Group at the beginning of the year. The first issues seem to be concentrating on the 'nostalgia' side of the market but hopefully they will expand into more specialised jazz albums. We will wait and see.

### **Lake**

Four new issues, including a 'two for the price of one' Mulligan/Melly listed as coming in the next month and hopefully these will be in stock very shortly.

### **Stomp Off**

## **Interesting Release of the Month**

The American Archeophone label which specialises in historical releases has an interesting new release this month entitled, "Debate '08" which has recordings of the '08 presidential debate from USA. Not between Obama and McCain in 2008 but between William Taft and William Bryan in 1908! At least 100 years ago the 2 minute limit to the recordings meant that the speeches were short! The album comes with a 80 page full colour booklet and judging by the website listing some of the 1908 problems are still here in 2008. This CD is a little obscure to stock but I can certainly order it for you should you wish to amaze your friends with the breadth of your CD

collection!
