Dear Friends,

Hopefully a nice collection of new release for you to select from this month including some LPs! The quantity of listed items seems to continue at around the same pace but there would see to be less and less issues being put out by the major companies. Anyway lets hope there is some thing to tempt you on the following pages.

Label News

Disconforme LPs

I'm not too sure why but the spanish labels are now issuing increasing number of 12 " LPs and a batch of a dozen are listed on page two. They are not cheap and postage will have to be more than for a single CD. The rate will be £1:50 per album and more if you are overseas.

Fresh Sound

Not all the CDs listed on page two will be available this month but I am pretty sure that they will be in before Christmas.

Music Mecca

It is quite some time since I have been able to offer CDs on this label but stocking by a UK distributor will be starting very soon. I have listed the last fifty or so issues although earlier numbers will be available for special order. I am hopeful that stocks will be to hand fairly shortly.

Retrospective

This is a new label being managed by Ray Crick who was one of the team behind the late lamented 'Living Era' label. The plan is for there to be a sustained programme of issues over the coming months with a catalogue target of around 400 albums. The music base will be nostalgia and jazz in a rather similar manner to the old label and I have listed all the initial issues in order that you can get an idea of the expected musical range. Distribution is being handled by the same company as dealing with the Nimbus label, hence the listing of their jazz issues on page 3.

Kazoo Lips

I think that I have to admit defeat with these. I have ordered these through my usual American supplier but he has been having great difficulty in obtaining stocks. Also the general production is very shabby. If you have any items from the catalogue on order and have paid in advance I will send the necessary refund, unless of course you want to order something else. A shame as it was a promising exercise - it just needed someone who knew what they were doing!

The Credit Crunch

Last month I was being as optimistic as possible and so far thing are okay. However there is one area where the financial situation is having a direct effect and that is American Imports. As you will be aware I get stocks of labels such as GHB,

Jazzology, Stomp Off, Mosaic etc. from an American wholesaler and consequently have to settle his accounts in US\$. Over the past five months or so sterling has declined against the dollar by 20 to 25 percent and whilst I can absorb some of the increase I'm afraid some of it will have to be passed on. I am currently waiting for a shipment, including the latest Stomp Off issues and will work out a current price when they arrive. Hopefully our currency will climb back up soon!

Orders

For a safer way to place orders for those of you who do not trust the regular email system may I suggest that you use the 'secure' order page on the website. Unlike many other 'online' shopping facilities this is a free text form so you can order anything even if it does not appear anywhere in the online catalogue. There is also no necessity to have all the details of the ordered album to hand as long as there is enough for me to identify it!

Credit Cards

When phoning, emailing or using the secure order form on the website please can you ensure that you quote the 'security' number on the back of the credit or debit card. This number is required by my card machine when processing 'card holder absent' transactions. This together with the post code and house number acts as a security check and whilst I can override this I am charged a penalty by the merchant service provider if I do this. If you choose not to divulge this number I may have to ask for payment by cheque sometime in the future as I will not be able to process cards without it.
