Dear Friends,

First this is rather a slim newsletter this month with a paucity of new release information. This largely reflects the time of year but I suspect that the current financial situation may have played a part. You will also have received my sales list a couple of days ago.

## **Label News**

This really should be called 'Distributor News' as the main item to report is that the major distributor, Pinnacle Entertainment Ltd., went into administration at the beginning of December and ceased trading immediately. This company was my source for a number of labels such as Timeless, Retrieval, ECM, Acrobat, etc. and whilst the record companies themselves are currently still in business actually getting hold of their CDs is causing some problems. Things are getting sorted slowly sorted with some labels supplying me directly and others finding a new distribution set up but if your order is delayed it this may be the cause. There are other changes as well with other distributors which may cause problems of their own but we shall survive!

## **American Imports**

As you will see from the following pages there have been quite a number of new releases on some of the specialist American labels including more from George Buck. Those which have not reached me yet should be here within two weeks. My American supplier and I are experimenting with different shipping methods in an attempt to keep prices down but maintain a reasonable delivery speed. Luckily the pound seems to have halted it's spiral down against the US\$ so the prices quoted should remain in force for some time.

## **Price Changes**

Of course the pound has also been declining against the Euro which results in higher prices for European imports. Whilst by no means an exclusive list the table below shows the new prices I am having to charge for a number of French and Spanish imports. I have tried to list the popular labels I know about at the moment but I am certain that more increases will follow for the labels not on the list. These new prices will take effect immediately I'm afraid but if you already have items on order then I will let you have them at the old price.

There may also be some price changes evolving from the distributions changes mentioned above.

## **Norwich Jazz Party**

Since I last mentioned this event in the Newsletter there has been an addition to the cast list. Not a new face to the NJP but very welcome indeed nonetheless. Firstly Sir John Dankworth has asked to come back for his third appearance and this
