Dear Friends,

Firstly let me thank you for supporting my 'Sale'. It considerably helped the cash flow situation. Not everything has gone so it might be worth a second stab if there are still some albums you want at the lower prices although I would warn you that many are now out of stock.

The last month has been difficult from a trading point of view as there have been a number of changes to distribution set-ups and record labels which have complicated the day-to-day ordering. If you have not received your order it is quite likely that something has happened to cause me problems but I will do my best to get things sorted even if it takes longer than usual.

There being rather a shortage of new release this month I have taken the opportunity to add details of a few albums from back copies of the Newsletter which you may have missed.

Janet Cook and Jazz Journal International

Many of you will now be aware that Janet Cook who has been editing Jazz Journal for some time since Eddie Cook became ill, died rather suddenly at the end of January resulting in the magazine ceasing publication immediately. Janet, Eddie and the JJI have been a great help to me and the business over the past thirteen years and my adverts therein have provided plenty of orders over the years. I shall certainly miss Janet's regular monthly phone call chasing the copy for the advert which I have always left to the last minute and I am sure that many of us will be very sad to see the demise of the magazine. There are a number of other jazz magazines on the market but I'm sure that JJI had a special place for many people particularly those interested in the mainstream of jazz be it contemporary or historical recordings. We can but hope that someone will take over the reins and get it back into circulation. In the meantime I'm sure our thoughts are with Eddie and the family.

Label News

Acrobat

This independent label was one of the victims of the collapse of the distributors, Pinnacle Entertainment, and it seemed to result in the record company themselves going into liquidation just after I had managed to open an account with them! However a company named 'Future Noise Music' have started up and have taken over the back catalogue and whilst new releases, which may or may not include jazz titles, will be under the new label name there is quite a quantity of old issues still in the warehouse. Therefore I have listed the jazz related items on page two and invite orders. How long these will remain available I do not know so I would not delay if anything takes your fancy.

Avid

For some reason one of the major distribution companies has decided to stop

distribution this label (and West End) together with labels such as Delta, Essential, Music and again I am having to open accounts with new companies to be able to supply. There there might be a delay in supplying any new releases listed or back catalogue items.

Vanguard

This label which is part of the Ace group of labels was another to be distributed by Pinnacle but I have now arranged direct supplies so there should be no problems. To celebrate I have listed the jazz and blues albums on the label but should any of you have wider tastes I can supply anything from the Ace catalogue.

New Note Distribution

This company which handled marketing, via Pinnacle, of a number of labels including, Retrieval, Timeless, Saga, Woodville, Telarc, ECM, Flare, Sepia, and around thirty others has also been dragged down by the demise of Pinnacle but many of their label distribution arrangements have been taken over by Proper Music Distribution and hopefully it will not be too long before normal service can be resumed for at least some of the labels. Because of the machinations of liquidation administrators some of the CDs might take a while to come though and some labels made indeed take their arrangements elsewhere so I am very loathe to make any promises.

Supplies from USA

A little more cheerful here! So far my American supplier is still going probably because like me he is a 'one man band' and orders for labels like VMP, GHB, Inner City, Victoria etc. are coming through reasonably regularly

if a little slowly. Because of the volatility of the British pound against the US dollar I am not ordering large quantities because I do not want to be holding a large amount of dead stock but hopefully this will work favourably as small orders can be sent without jewel cases by regular mail which is quicker and cheaper than using a major carrier.

As you will see I am facing quite a lot of difficulties at the moment and although I believe I can keep going, it's all them others! No help or encouragement seems to be emanating from our political or business leaders who seem to take a positive delight in trying to outdo each other and score meaningless political points in describing how bad things are and how they are going to get worse. We all know that there are world-wide economic problems but maybe it is about time that someone took a leaf out of the Barrack Obama election campaign and when asked if we can get through this responded with the slogan, "Yes, we can!"

Jazz is a music which has the ability to capture the individual mood and there can be nothing better than listening to one's favourite music to make one forget the cares and woes of the day.

That's about it for this month. Happy listening.

Comment:- It is not often that I can include a Grammy winner in the newsletter but the first volume of these two recently won the award for the 'Best Historical Album' and it is quite possible that the second volume will fill the same slot next year. They are excellent productions with each set being accompanied by a book which gives background information about each of the tracks and the performers. The recordings all come from 50 years work by Art Rosenbaum documenting the true 'folk' music of rural America and the material is fascinating. The price might seem a trifle high when compared with other sets but I would consider it worth paying if you are interested in the historical aspects of American music.
