Label News

Robinwood

This is the only label given a complete listing this month. It is a small independent label with an interesting collection of issues. Apart from the newest Scott Hamilton / Danny Moss CD the others are available to order rather than from stock.

Inner City / Classic Jazz

These two American labels continue to put out an array of issues with a wide musical styling. The 'Inner City' issues tend mainly to be old LP albums transferred onto CD, such as the Clifford Brown and Bechet / Solal whereas many of the 'Classic Jazz' CDs are taken from the 'Music Minus One' catalogue which have been previously available for tuition purposes. Unfortunately the price is rather high but reflects the current exchange rates.

The Buck Group

Comment:- I must admit that I was rather disappointed by this album. The 'Guys And Dolls' album which came earlier was very good but this one seems very bland and distinctly lacking in any energy. I am not sure if the songs from this show respond very well to this type of treatment or maybe it is the actual arrangements but unfortunately I cannot really recommend this CD.
