Time for another newsletter to tempt you! Hopefully you will find something on the following pages to order as it is only with your help that Jazz 'n' Blues Records can keep going!

Label News

The Buck Group

Although I was hoping that the latest issues would have arrived by now at least I am able to include a few more details on pages 2 and 3 which should give you a better opportunity in making an informed judgement as to whether to purchase. My own ordering for stock had to be based on the earlier information so it may be that I have ordered insufficient quantities!

'Future Issues'

The first couple of pages of the newsletter always contains lists of projected new releases which I put together largely from either information which is sent to me by suppliers or gleaned from various internet sites. Sometimes the information is rather vague particularly when it comes to release dates. For example on page 2 I have listed a batch of new releases on the Fresh Sound label but it may be that they will not actually be available until sometimes in August so please bear with me if there is a wait for items listed on the first couple of pages.

Prices

With the fluctuation of Sterling against other currencies particularly the US Dollar and the Euro the prices I am having to pay seem to be constantly changing. The good news this month is that because of the current improvement in the US\$:\$ rate I have been able to reduce the prices on labels such as Inner City and Classic Jazz. Hopefully other imported American labels will follow suit. Also some of the European labels have reduced in price by small amounts but here I am completely in the hands of my suppliers who will be in Sterling!

Label Distribution

There are still a number of changes happening with the distribution of a number of labels which has not been helped by the closing down of Cadillac Jazz Distribution in London who has been regularly supplying me since I took over the business. I believe that the proprietors of this small organisation, John and Hazel, have decided to retire and whilst I wish them all the best for the future it means there will be a hiatus in supplies of stock including Arbors, Jazz Oracle, Sackville, 504, and several others. A number of labels have already found new homes but it will take a little while before everything settles down. Elsewhere other labels, such as Storyville

and Steeplechase are are moving and sometimes keeping up is not that easy!

Postal Rates

A few months ago I threatened new postal charges based on the changes introduced in April. I have now worked out the implications of these and my new charges are set out on the back page of the newsletter. They are also detailed on the enclosed order form and also on the web-site.

Away Days

There are a couple of festival visits planned over the next six weeks or so when the office will be closed. Aply assisted by my wife, I will be setting up the stall at the Whitley Bay International Jazz Festival at the Village Hotel in Newcastle from Friday 10th to Sunday 12th July inclusively. This is probably the best Festival in the country specialising in bands playing in the 'Classic' jazz style and it is truly an International affair with bands coming from Canada, Switzerland, Italy, Sweden, France and even Gateshead the other side of the Tyne. If sure there are still tickets available so why not come along.

At the beginning of August, all things being equal, we will be making a further visit to the Nairn Jazz Festival which is planned to run through from 1st to 9th of the month. As usual everything seems to be late in planning but I'm sure that there will be an exciting programme of mainstream jazz running throughout the week.

Credit / Debit Card Security Number

It is important that you include the last three digits of the number on the back of your credit or debit cards when placing orders by form or over the phone. In future failure to do this will result in me either being unable to accept this method of payment or having to make a supplementary charge to cover the extra processing fee. It is a process to protect both of us from fraudulent use of the card.
