## **Label News**

### **JSP Boxed sets**

From now until the end of December this sets are available at the reduced price of £12.95 which is almost £5 off the normal amount. I have briefly listed the jazz albums but all of the Blues and Country CD sets are also available at the reduced price. If you would like a full list of these, plus further details of the jazz albums please let me know.

### **Classic Jazz / Inner City**

As some of you will be aware there has been a delay in getting hold of albums on this label which came through my regular American wholesaler. However the record company now wish to supply me direct and accordingly I have order some from the back catalogue plus some of the new issues. I have listed the entire catalogue and whilst I do not intend to keep everything in stock they can be obtained on special order. I am not sure of the delivery time until the first order has come through and I can be certain of the service levels.

### **Jazz Oracle**

With the demise of Cadillac Jazz Distribution this excellent Canadian label was left with no distribution. However this is now sorted out and the full catalogues is now available again - hence the full listing. I'm sorry that there is a price increase but this largely reflects the change in the currency exchange rate over the last year or so. If and when the economic climate improves maybe the price will be able to be reduced - you never know!

### **Brilliant Jazz**

This Dutch organisation is continuing to put out budget priced sets with the minimum of information. There are seven listed below and another seven planned for issue later in October. I have included what information I can but sometime the information is rather slipshod with odd spelling mistakes. Most of the recordings have been available before on various budget labels such as Membran and Union Square. They are a discographers delight or nightmare depending how you look at it!

## **Credit and Debit Cards**

I have recently changed my merchant service provider and the new system will

not allow me to take cards for 'card holder not present' transactions when I have not been given the three digit 'CWW' or security number from the back of the card. Therefore in future I must insist that if you wish to pay by card you must include this number with the order be it placed by phone or by post. Also for cost reasons I have decided to stop taking American Express cards with effect from the end of this month. I have to maintain a separate account for these transactions and this has proved simply not worth it given that I only handle around 12 to 15 Amex transactions a year. I hope this will not cause you to many problems. At least I am very happy to keep taking cheques which is something I have over Tesco's and the other supermarkets!

A considerable affection for the music comes across not least in the vocals of Becky Kilgore who has made a number of 'western swing' albums in the past. An excellent album of entertaining music.
