Label News

Lonehill

As a special Christmas offer I have listed the entire Lonehill catalogue as available. Over the years this label from Spain has developed into an excellent jazz label offering over 250 albums mostly of a style which could be best described as 'mainstream'. The Christmas Offer price is £9.00 for single albums; £14.50 for doubles and £17.50 for triples with an additional 10% off for label orders totalling £75 or more. This stands for orders received on or before Friday 18th December. I'm sure you can find plenty to tempt you.

Jazz Crusade

I have heard that Bill Bissonnette is now semiretired and the Jazz Crusade labels may not exist for very much longer. Therefore I have listed the current catalogue at a special 2009 price of £11.00 (or 10 CDs for £100) which will last through until the 27th November when a bulk order will be sent to the States. Hopefully therefore supplies will arrive for despatch before Christmas. This may be your last opportunity to purchase albums on this label so delay could be problematic!

Brilliant Jazz / House Of Jazz

This label from Holland is very strange. I have listed a further 8 boxed sets which sell at the very low price of £19.50 and having listened to a random selection I can say the sound is fine. The notes are minimal or almost non-existent but what should one expect at this price! I have visited the website listed on the boxes and none of the sets are mentioned at all - all very strange!

JSP Sets

A gentle reminder that the JSP multi-CD sets that were listed are still available at the reduced price of £12.95 until the end of December but I would suggest that you get any order in as soon as possible to ensure you get the benefit of the reduction.

VAT

An early reminder that the rate of VAT reverts to 17.5% with effect from January 1st 2010 and after this date all invoices will have to reflect this if of course you live in the UK or EU and have to pay the tax!. Comment:- As you gather from my stock number and the catalogue number this is not a new album but a reissue of one that has been out of print for some time. These tracks from the pre-Parlophone days demonstrate that even in those days Humph was his own man including a number of original compositions as well as variations from the usual 'traditional jazz' format. Mention is made in the notes of the Esquire Record label upon which most of these tracks first appeared and it should be mentioned that co-founder, along with Carlo Kramer, of the label, Peter Newbrook, died last June.
