Upbeat Jazz

Much of their material, but by no means all, has been gleaned from the BBC radio archives so the recording quality is certainly good. If you wish to check details of the albums before purchasing they are listed in detail on www.upbeat.co.uk. The price is higher from that site however!

I have also listed the entire catalogue of these two Spanish labels which are issuing a number of well known albums as they drop out of the fifty year copyright restrictions. How longer this practice will continue is anyone's guess as I believe a European law has been accepted extending the copyright period and this awaits ratification by member states before it is enforced and puts most of the specialist labels and suppliers (such as your truly) out of business.

As you will see from the cast list above the Norwich Jazz Party to be held at the Holiday Inn adjacent to Norwich International Airport has managed to put together an impressive list of musicians from both sides of the Atlantic.

We are particularly pleased to have secured the services of Annie Ross who, as many of you will know, has enjoyed a very long career which stretches back to her film debut at a very young age in *Our Gang Follies of 1938*. Possibly best known as part of the "Lambert, Hendricks and Ross" vocal trio in the late fifties and early sixties during the course of her career she has been accompanied by many of the jazz greats including Chet Baker, Gerry Mulligan, the members of the MJQ and Tommy Flanagan plus many, many more. Currently singing regularly at the Metropolitan Room in New York accompanied by Warren Vache and Tardo Hammer this month she is due to be honoured by the American National Endowment for the Arts as one of the eight recipients of the 2010 Jazz Master Fellowship together with such luminaries as Bill Holman, Kenny Barron, Bobby Hutcherson, Cedar Walton and George Avakian. This award is the highest honour that the US government bestows on jazz musicians.

As usual the exact programming will not be done until a couple of weeks before the event once full consultations have taken place with all the musicians. We firmly believe that our policy of involving the players fully in the programming has been one of the factors which has made the Norwich Jazz Party one of the best in the world.

Tickets for the whole weekend which runs from 3pm on Saturday afternoon until late Monday night are still available but if you think that around 26 hours of top-flight jazz is a little too much for you or your companion individual day tickets can now be purchased. Weekend tickets are priced at £160 and day tickets at £57.50.
