## **Label News**

**504**

On the heels of the Lake and Upbeat listings in the past couple of months I have included a complete list of this other British label which specialises in traditional jazz this time with a strong leaning towards the New Orleans Revival. Some excellent albums plus some very much for the specialist in this area. All should be readily available.

### **American Jazz Classics / Poll Winners Records**

Two more Spanish / Andorran labels who are picking through the back catalogues of the major labels who seem to show no interest in reissuing their old LP releases. As you will see the problem is that there is a certain amount of duplication with 'classic' LPs cropping up as reissues on different labels. It pays to be wary.

### **Euroarts - Masters of American Music**

This a series of ten shows from a series of documentaries each running to around one hour and covering a wide range of music. The blurb I have been sent suggests that it was the first TV series devoted to jazz but this seems a little far-fetched!

### **Jazz Wax Records**

For those who feel that the LP is a superior product for sound we have a series of classic 1950's albums reissued in 'high-definition premium vinyl pressing for superior fidelity.' I cannot make any comments on the actual quality as I have not heard any of them but they do seem a little pricey to me!

### **Sounds of Yesteryear**

I have listed all the forthcoming issues on this label that I am aware of, but should warn you that it will be two to three months before they are available, particularly the higher numbers.

### **T2 Entertainment**

This triple CD sets will be arriving early next month and come from the same stable as the various 'Brilliant' sets I have listed over past months so I suspect they will have the bare minimum of information but very acceptable sound.

### **George Buck Labels.**

I really do not know what is happening in New Orleans at the moment. New releases were announced well before Christmas a number of which looked very tempting but nothing further has happened. You will see one new album listed by Sharkey Bonano and I have managed to get a very small supply of this but goodness when the others will arrive if indeed they ever do!

### **Vocalion**

A gentle word of warning with this label. There is a tendency for their issues to remain in the catalogue for a relatively short space of time before being deleted. Most of the previous issues with the CDNJT prefix have now gone as well as many of the dance band series. So I would suggest that if you see

something you fancy go without your supper one night and buy it before it vanishes!

Subtitled 'The Musicians, the Records & The Music of the 78 Era' this publication is an A4 size book with 178 pages very well printed and containing a great number of historical illustrations and photos both in colour and black and white. It contains around 16 articles by a variety of very knowledgeable writers including Joe Moore, Christopher Hillman, John Collinson and the editor, Paul Swinton. Subjects covered include Big Charlie Thomas, the Life and Music of Arnold Wiley, Thomas Morris and the Golden Age of Jazz Piano. Loving produced it is to be hoped that this will be the first of a regular series. The book comes with a CD of 26 rare jazz and blues recordings excellently remastered by Nick Dellow.
