Dear Friends,

Here we go with the third newsletter for 2010 with a fairly good range of new CDs to offer. Compared with a couple of years ago the number and range of new CD releases is down and certain labels do not seem as active as they were. It would seem that the bigger companies such as EMI/Blue Note and Sony Columbia have given up jazz altogether which is very sad given their vast back catalogues. There would also seem to be an increase in the number of budget labels issuing out-of-copyright material. Whether this is a good thing in the long run remains to be seen as obviously they will concentrate on the more popular recordings from 50 years ago - e.g. Brubeck's 'Time Out' and not bother with the lesser known albums which would be of greater interest to the real 'jazz'. We will have to wait and see.

Label News

Crystal Stream

For those of you who do not know it this Australian label issues CD-Rs mostly of dance bands from the U.K., USA and Australia and the albums are generally made to order. I have listed the most recent fifty or so on page 2 and have placed an stock order from the very recent which hopefully will be here in about two weeks.
