### **Fresh Sound**

### **George Buck Labels**

Stock of the new releases have arrived in the last couple of weeks but three additional releases have now come out and these should be with me over the next month or so.

### **Crystal Stream**

My initial stock of this Australian label have now arrived and are listed on the following pages. Whilst basically a label covering dance bands of the 1920s and 1930s rather than strictly 'jazz' as you will see there are some albums which will appeal to jazz collectors. Although I have not listened to every album I have been very pleasantly surprised at the sound quality which is generally excellent. **Comment:-** This is a little bit different from most Lake issues being of a much more mainstream jazz style but it is certainly an excellent album which amply demonstrates that the UK has a bunch of world class trombone players who can swing like crazy. All but two of the arrangements are by Adrian Fry and show a wonderful lightness of touch and variance of mood. This very much looks like being my "CD of the Month" unless something better comes along in the next couple of weeks which seems very unlikely.

**Comment:-** The Bob Wallis band became unfairly maligned in some circles as the epitome of 'trad jazz' but whilst their music, particularly in 1959, was not that subtle it had a raw excitement which summed up for many what the boom was all about - a good time with dancing, smoking, boozing and usually chasing girls. That the band played good jazz was a bonus and I always looked forward to their appearances at the Grosvenor Ballroom in Norwich which has now, sadly, been replaced by an office block and Kentucky Fried Chicken! Great stuff and recommended.
